3.Introductory informations

The 12th edition of the World Futnet Championships takes place in Cluj-Napoca, Romania between 16 and 18 November 2018 and is organized by the Futnet Romania Association and the Union Internationale de Futnet.

Main part of tournament will be held on the main court in the POLYVALENT Municipal Sports Hall, in Cluj-Napoca, Romania.

Matches will be played simultaneously on the Court 2 of the Polyvalent Hall and on other two courts in the “Gheorghe Roman” Sport Hall (belonging to the Faculty of Physical Education and Sport Cluj-Napoca).

The World FUTNET Championships will feature 3 competitions:

- 1. World FUTNET Championship - SINGLE**
- 2. World FUTNET Championship - DOUBLE**
- 3. World FUTNET Championship - TRIPLE**

4.Venue



POLYVALENT Municipal Sports Hall

5. Costs covered by organisers

a) Accommodation:

Number of members for which we offer full board: **6 players + 1 coach**
(The organisers would cover accommodation for 4 nights: **from Thursday 15.11 to Monday 20.11**)

We offer full board for referees, but UNIF will decide on this issue. Some countries may bring two referees, while other none.

We offer full board to the UNIF staff as UNIF Executive Board decides.

b) Meals

Organizers will arrange the evening meal on 15.Nov, 3 meals per day on 16,17,18 Nov and breakfast on 19 Nov.

We ask delegations with restrictions on certain foods to announce this in advance.

c) Transportation

The organisers will also provide transfer from Cluj Napoca Airport within the city.
Low-cost tickets from Bucharest International Airport are not covered, but can be booked by local organisers.

8. Referees

Referees are nominated by UNIF Head of referees **Mr. Vlastimil Stehlík**. Only the referees with international UNIF certification are allowed arbitrate to the games.

UNIF will pay the financial remuneration to all participating referees.

9. Awards, Prize

Cups and medals will be awarded for the top 3 teams for each category and the title “**Best Nation**” (Cumulative).

Plus other material awards: cups, diplomas, medals, etc.

11. Conditions of participation

World Championships are open to all UNIF member and non-member national associations as well as the countries where no national futnet association has been formed yet after complying with the following conditions:

1. Registration for participation as a minimum in two disciplines (if the championships is held in two divisions, the countries in top division must register for all three disciplines)
2. Payment of the corresponding fees within the deadline
3. Nomination of eligible players

Priority will be given to UNIF member and candidate nations, then to new nations. In case of other countries, the order in which the applications have been sent will be taken into account.

The maximum number of participants is 26 countries.

12. Eligibility of players

The players must hold the citizenship of the country they represent and be able to prove it with a valid passport or another official identification card. All the players must be included in the official nomination list signed by their national futnet association or the corresponding authority/official in case of the countries with no national association. All the players in one double or triple must be members of the same national futnet association. One player may participate in all three disciplines. In case the player is eligible to play for two or more countries, he may play for different national teams, but never in the same year.

National associations are responsible for the state of health of all the members of their delegation and shall ensure that they have full health insurance. U18 players can participate only with the declaration of honour on their state of fitness signed by the head of delegation.

Names of the players are not required with the application form, they will be necessary at a later stage for accreditation and promotion purposes.

13. Application form

All countries have to send in the application form, duly filled in, signed and scanned **before 31 July** and pay the corresponding participation fees also **before 31 July** to the account given at the end of this document.

14. Participation fee

All UNIF members that are in good standing within UNIF and EFTA have the right to participate free of charge, paying only the player's registration fee (see below).

Non-UNIF members shall pay the following participation fee:

- | 250 EUR – new countries if this is their first or second participation at UNIF or EFTA international competition
- | 600 EUR – other non-member countries

15. Players' registration fee

A registration fee of 15 EUR per player shall be paid by all teams upon arrival during accreditation on Thursday 15 November.

16. Refereeing fee

There is an obligation of presence of one UNIF-licensed referee for each UNIF member. The referee cannot be one of the players or coaches taking part in the championships. If the country has no referee, it shall pay 200 EUR to UNIF Technical Committee at the technical meeting before the championships (via bank transfer or on site in cash).

Referees from UNIF non member countries are welcome to referee education seminar to obtain the UNIF license. The seminar should take place one day prior to the start of the tournament. Details will be published on the official website.
